STALIN SEEKS STATUS QUO FOR 30 YEARS; BJP & ALLIES SKIP MEET

All-party meeting in TN 'rejects' delimitation

AN ALL-PARTY MEETING convened by Tamil Nadu chief minister MK Stalin has "unanimously rejected" the Parliamentary constituency delimitation process, expected to take place in 2026.

Delimitation will "weaken" Tamil Nadu and be a "threat to India's federal structure", a resolution passed at the meeting in Chennai on Wednesday said. The ruling DMK, AIADMK, Congress, Viduthala Chiruthaigal Katchi, Tamilaga Vetri Kazhagam and the Left parties attended the meeting. The BJP, Naam Tamilar Katchi and Tamil Maanila Congress boycotted it.

According to the resolution passed at the meeting, delimitation based "exclusively" on population figures from the upcoming census will affect "the political representation rights of Tamil Nadu and other South Indian states".

The resolution read, "It is entirely unjustifiable to reduce parliamentary representation of Tamil Nadu and other south Indian states solely because they have proactively implemented

population control measures in the national interest." The all-party meeting also resolved that the freeze on delimitation based on the 1971 population census, "which extends until 2026, should be extended for the foreseeable future". In a separate address at the all-party meeting, Stalin said that the "status-quo should continue for at least three decades".

The all-party meeting also resolved to constitute a Joint Action Committee (JAC) of different political parties of Tamil Nadu. The JAC will extend an invitation to political parties in other south Indian states to join in "the fight against delimitation", the resolution read.

In his address, Stalin said that southern states should "collectively oppose" delimitation based on population. He added that the voice of Tamil Nadu, which has 39 MPs in the Parliament, is still not being considered by the Centre.

"A delimitation exercise will only make matters worse," he said. Stalin had earlier said that Tamil Nadu's share of MPs would reduce to 31 from 39 if delimitation based on population is implemented.

On Wednesday, he said, "If the number of parliamentary seats is increased to 848, Tamil Nadu should get 22 seats in addition. But if delimitation is based on population, we will get only 10 seats, thereby losing 12 seats."

In either case, "the voice of Tamil Nadu will be suppressed", he said.

Stalin also said that his government would take "all measures to prevent implementation of delimitation", which poses a "grave danger" to Tamil Nadu.

Focus on trade, tech, Ukraine as Jaishankar meets Starmer

DAYS AFTER HE hosted an emergency meeting of European leaders in support of Ukraine and its President Volodymyr Zelenskyy — after the latter's public showdown with US President Donald Trump and Vice-President JD Vance at the White House — British Prime Minister Keir Starmer "shared UK's perspective" on the conflict with External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar in London on Tuesday night.

Besides bilateral ties, including on trade and technology, Jaishankar, who is on a six-day

visit to the UK and Ireland, also discussed the Ukraine conflict in a meeting with his counterpart, British Foreign Secretary David Lammy.

"Delighted to call on Prime Minister @Keir Starmer at @10DowningStreet today. Conveyed the warm greetings of PM @narendramodi. Discussed taking forward our bilateral, economic cooperation and enhancing people-to-people exchanges. PM Starmer also shared UK's perspective on the Ukraine conflict," Jaishankar posted on X.

"Held wide-ranging and productive talks with Foreign Secretary @DavidLammy over past two days at the Chevening House. We discussed the entire gamut of bilateral ties, especially our focus on strategic coordination, political cooperation, trade deal negotiation, education, technology, mobility and people-to-people exchanges. Agreed to formulate the next steps to further strengthen and structure them," Jaishankar said.

MHA view sought on Kejriwal security

A MONTH AFTER the defeat of AAP national convener Arvind Kejriwal in the Delhi Assembly polls, the Delhi Police security unit has decided to ask the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) whether the security cover provided to him should continue or

be scaled down. It is learnt that the security unit has sent a letter to the Delhi Police headquarters for the MHA, seeking a decision on the security cover for Kejriwal. He currently has 'Z plus' security cover, provided by MHA based on the threat perception, and Z-category security which was given by Delhi Police. As per protocol, the Delhi

CM is entitled to Z-category security, which can be enhanced after an assessment. Because of multiple security threats, the MHA had granted 'Z plus' security cover to Kejriwal and the Z-category security was given by Delhi Police even after he resigned from the CM post in September 2024. "Assessment of the threat perception of VIP or

VVIPs are conducted by security agencies on the direction of the MHA," a senior officer said. "A letter has been sent to the PHQ from the security unit, informing it about the current status of his security cover and seeking a decision on whether the current security status should continue or be downgraded," a source said.
